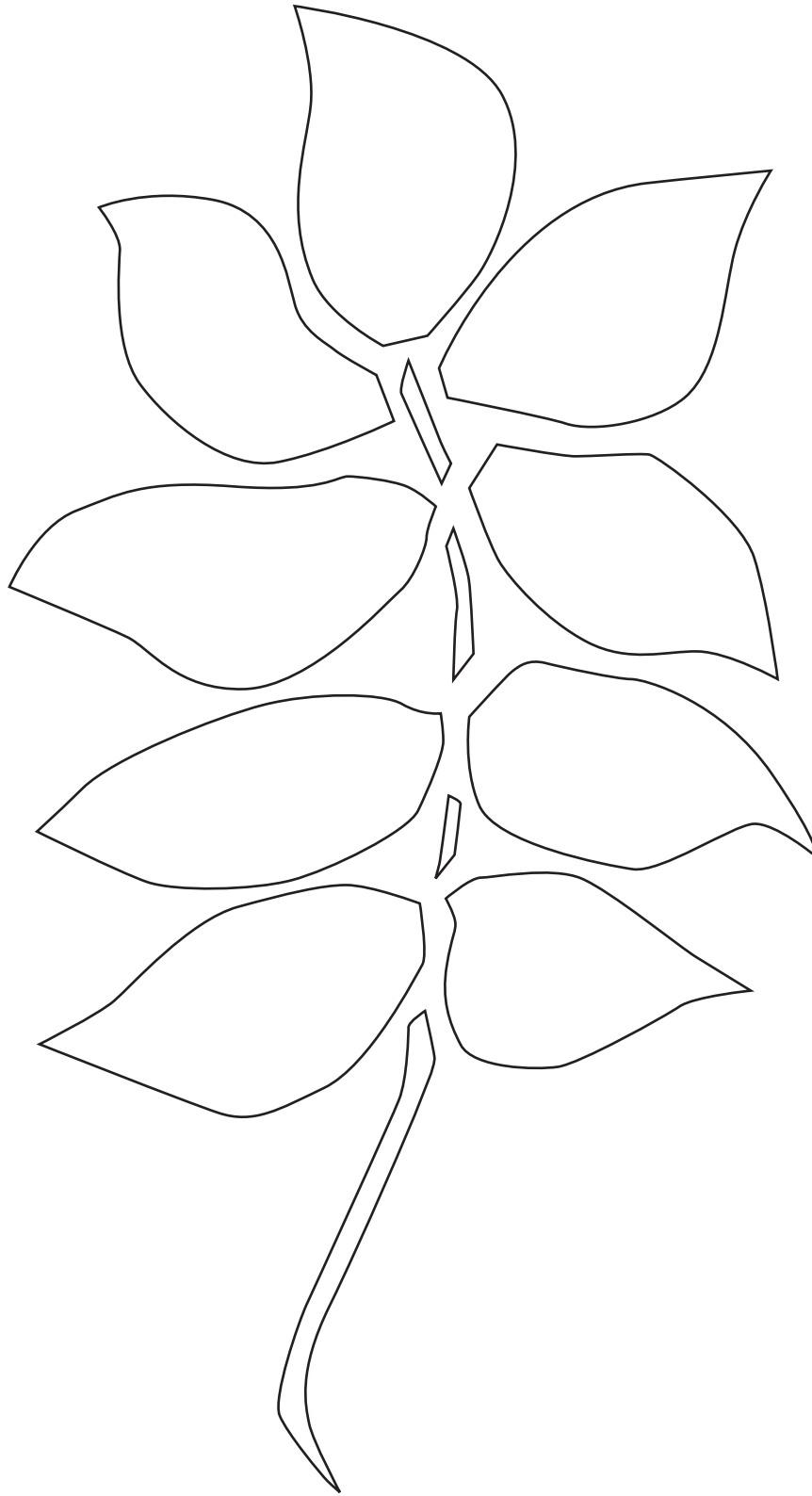

STENCIL INSTRUCTIONS

Size of pattern

The pattern in the Taika Guide and Colour Guide has been enlarged to fill an A3-size sheet of paper. You can enlarge the pattern, for example with a photocopier (200% enlargement). You can copy the enlarged pattern to a positioning film or equivalent large film available from stationery shops. If you want to use the pattern as it is at the approximately A4 size, you can print it out directly on a transparency for cutting.

Working instructions

1. Place the stencil model under the film and trace the pattern with a waterproof felt-tip pen.
2. Cut the pattern out from the film with a wallpaper knife or surgical scalpel.
3. Spray adhesive glue on the reverse side of the stencil to keep it on the wall during the painting period. You can also attach the stencil with painter's tape.
4. Position the stencil on the surface to be painted.
5. Paint the pattern with a foam plastic stippler or stencil stippler thinly by gently applying Feelings Interior Paint. Repeat the treatment so that the colour is covering.
6. Carefully remove the stencil from its base.
7. Move the stencil to the desired area and repeat the treatment. You can apply one or several "Leaf" patterns or they can be scattered all over the wall.
8. Wash the stencil with water. If the paint has had a chance to dry, you can clean the stencil with Tikkurila's Pensselipesu (Tool Cleaner) or Maalipesu (Cleaning Agent).
