STENCIL INSTRUCTIONS

Size of pattern

The pattern in the Taika Guide and Colour Guide has been enlarged to fill an A1-size sheet of paper. You can enlarge the pattern, for example with a photocopier (400% enlargement). You can copy the enlarged pattern to a positioning film or equivalent large film available from stationery shops. If you want to use the pattern as is at the approximately A4 size, you can print it out directly on a transparency for cutting.

Working instructions

1. Place the stencil model under the film and trace the pattern with a waterproof felt-tip pen. Draw a vertical guideline in the middle of the pattern to facilitate its alignment on the wall.
2. Cut the pattern out from the film with a wallpaper knife or surgical scalpel.
3. Spray adhesive glue on the reverse side of the stencil to keep it on the wall during the painting period. You can also attach the stencil with painter's tape.
4. Position the stencil on the surface to be painted. To keep the pattern vertical, check the vertical guideline you drew through its centre with a spirit level.
5. Paint the pattern with a foam plastic stippler or stencil stippler thinly by gently applying Feelings Interior Paint so that the most colour remains at the pattern's edges.
6. Carefully remove the stencil from its base.
7. Move the stencil so that the pattern's outermost curves function as positioning marks; this enables you to continue a repetitive sequence as in a wallpaper pattern. (See Picture 2).
8. Wash the stencil with water. If the paint has had a chance to dry, you can clean the stencil with Tikkurila's Pensselipesu (Tool Cleaner) or Maalipesu (Cleaning Agent).
